History

At a Full Board meeting held on October 22, 2013, the Members disapproved the removal application by a split vote. Written reasons have not been issued.

Request to be considered

By letter dated October 27, 2013, the applicant requests reconsideration. He has set forth the populations of the surrounding municipalities. He claims that there are three or more stores within a two mile radius in Albion and Armonk. He states that he has enclosed signed invoices from his wholesalers to show that deliveries were made only to his current store. He installed new signs on the storefront in August, so lack of notice should not be an issue, and he has displayed a public notice on the front door since the last meeting.

Recommendation of Counsel

With respect to the posted notice requirement, we may want to update the removal application to remind an applicant of that obligation. A new sign on the storefront may indicate that it's a done deal, and does not necessarily convey to the public that they may oppose the relocation of the package store. The key to the posted notice is that it invites the public to submit written comments and provides an address to which to send them.
