Description of Premises: The premises is located on the first floor and the cellar of a 3-story brick residential building located in a residential and business zoned area. The building also consists of 5 apartments on the 2nd and 3rd floors including the apartment leased by the current principal. There is no interior access to the 2nd and 3rd floor apartments from the premises. There are 3 doors used to access the premise. One door is located on Smith Street near the corner, another is located on Douglass Street near the corner where Smith Street begins, and one door is located further from the corner, in the middle of the block on Douglass Street. All three 3 doors are used for customers to enter and exit the premise during operating hours. There is an existing licensed sidewalk café with a total of 10 tables and 20 seats (4 tables with 8 seats on the Smith Street side of the premise and 6 tables with 12 seats on the Douglass Street side of the premise). The door located in the middle of the block on Douglass Street is also primarily used for wait staff to access the sidewalk café and for customers sitting in the sidewalk café to have easier access to the restroom located inside. The premise contains an interior maximum occupancy of 53 persons pursuant to the Certificate of Occupancy and consists of an unobstructed dining area with one 9 ft stand-up bar with a 5 ft return and 10 stools, 15 tables, seating for 35 persons, a kitchen and one restroom on the first floor. The cellar will be used for storage and contains one restroom. There is interior access via stairs between the first floor and the cellar and the restroom in the cellar is located immediately next to the stairs for customers' convenience.
