Question(s) to be considered: Applicant wishes to change the Method of Operation currently approved by the Members of the Authority.

Protests: No

Description of Premises: The premise is located on the ground floor and basement of a 5 story multi unit commercial and residential building. Premises consists of dining area, kitchen and restrooms. Basement is used for storage and has interior access. There is no interior access to other parts of the building. There is a stand up bar to the left upon entry and a pizza counter in the rear of the premise.

Method of Operation: Restaurant serving beer and wine only with approximately 10 employees. There will be background music only and no dancing. Principals will manage. The currently approved Method of Operation stipulates that the premise is to close daily by 11:00 p.m. with takeout service to close by 12:00 midnight. In addition, the French doors, located on the right of the establishment, must be closed by 9:00pm. Further stipulations imposed by the Members are as follows: Legal Occupancy to be 50 patrons unless an amended Certificate of Occupancy has been received by the Authority; Outside of premises is to be clean at all times; premises is limited to 7 bar stools; and no large televisions to be on the premises
