Question(s) to be considered: The licensee is proposing to add a second add bar for a total of three standup bars, and a large outdoor area measuring approximately 356' x 145'. The outside area includes the rear lawn with a patio and the side lawn with 4 volleyball courts. Patrons under the age of 21 will be allowed at the premises. Given the size and layout of the proposed area in addition to the currently licensed premise, is the proposed plan of supervision sufficient to assure compliance with the ABC Laws?

Description of Premises: The applicant has applied to license an additional bar to the basement banquet room. The banquet room itself measures approximately 2,604 square feet. The proposed bar is L-shaped and measures 8'6" x 19'5" in length. The applicant has advised that the bar is not newly constructed, but has always existed and was not used. The basement bar was not depicted in any of the original diagrams or photographs. The applicant is also seeking to license an outside lawn area to be enclosed by temporary portable fencing. The area measures 346' by 145' and includes a patio and four volleyball courts. The two volleyball courts located in the "island" surrounded by the parking lot and driveway at the front of the establishment are not included in the proposed licensed premise.

Method of Operation: The applicant has installed security statements that can be monitored live from the downstairs office, and/or reviewed via a recording at a later time. Sunday through Wednesday 2-3 managers will be on staff with one assigned to monitoring the grounds. Thursday through Saturday 4 managers will be on staff with between 4 and 6 security personnel. The applicant plans to utilize wristbands to distinguish underage patrons from patrons 21 and over. The proposed use of wrist bands will vary for different nights of the week. Only on Thursday nights will every patron be required to wear a bracelet showing if they are under 21 or of legal drinking age. Friday through Wednesday, some patrons will have bracelets showing they are under 21; some will have bracelets showing they are 21 or older, and some will have no bracelets at all. The applicant has outlined a detailed plan of supervision which is attached.

Description of Premises: The premise is located on the ground floor and mezzanine of a 1-story commercial building. The premise consists of a dining area with 16 tables, a total of 36 seats with 2 seats per table and 4 stools per the corner counter located near one of the restrooms (corner counter is not considered a food counter), an 18 foot stand-up bar with 10 stools, a kitchen, a storage room and two restrooms all located on the ground floor.
