To: SLA staff, all Wholesalers and Retailers of Alcoholic Beverages  
Subject: C.O.D. list reporting relief for Western New York Winter Storm Victims

This Advisory assumes compliance with Advisory 2011-1, Bulletins #166, #338 and #339 as well as Divisional Order #719.

In order to provide relief to victims of severe winter storms in the Western New York region the Members of the Authority hereby grant a thirty (30) day grace period postponing the C.O.D. list notification date (the date when wholesalers are required to report payment delinquencies to the SLA) for retail licensees in the following counties which experienced severe winter storm effects between November 15, 2014 and November 25, 2014: Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie, Franklin, Genesee, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Oswego and Wyoming.

The grace period provided hereby cannot alter the amount of the indebtedness that retailers owe their wholesalers but is merely intended to extend for an additional thirty (30) days the notification date for outstanding alcoholic beverage purchase invoices representing sales made prior to and remaining unpaid as of the date of this Advisory – thereby allowing retail licensees time to get their businesses up and running again without running afoul of C.O.D. list reporting requirements.
