

TO: ZONE OFFICES AND LOCAL BOARDS  
SUBJECT: SUMMER LICENSES - EXTENSIONS

Summer liquor licensees who wish to extend their license period up to November 30, may do so by notifying the Zone License Board in writing no later than 5 business days prior to the expiration of their current license, and by payment of the appropriate additional fee, and by furnishing the necessary bond to cover the additional period.

The earlier procedure, set forth in Divisional Order No. 767 - Amended (issued February 14, 1980), which required the licensee to notify the Authority at time of filing if an extension was requested, is hereby rescinded.
