On November 16, 2017, the State Liquor Authority will be hosting the first of three meetings with farm brewers across the state. The focus of the meeting is to help farm/micro brewers understand and meet the requirements of their license, as well as to further explain the many privileges allowed by the farm/micro brewer license. There will be an open Q & A session at the end of each meeting, allowing the brewers to ask any questions or voice any concerns they may have.

These meetings are a great opportunity for farm/micro brewers to network with members of the SLA, expand their knowledge about their license and learn more about how other farm/micro brewers in the state are using the license. All farm/micro brewers throughout the state are invited and encouraged to attend one of these meetings.

The first meeting will be held in Rochester at Monroe Community College, Building 8 – 4th Floor, 1000 East Henrietta Road on Thursday, November 16th from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The second meeting will be held in New York City at our Harlem Office, 317 Lenox Avenue, 5th Floor, Full Board Room on Thursday, November 30th from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The third meeting will be held in Albany at the Alfred E. Smith Office Building, 80 South Swan Street, Room 148 (main lobby) on Thursday, December 14th from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
